

Spedian Changeable Graphic System – Installation & Care Guide

Roadvert Ltd is committed to ensuring your Spedian graphics are applied to the highest standard. To help us achieve a flawless installation with minimal disruption to your fleet, we kindly ask that you prepare your vehicles in advance by following the steps below. Failure to do so may result in delays, additional charges, or rescheduled fitting appointments.

Initial Installation – Preparing for Your First Spedian Fit

To allow our professional certified installers to complete the work efficiently and safely, please ensure:

- **Vehicle Scheduling**

- All vehicles scheduled for fitting should be available consecutively, with no significant gaps between their availability.
- Any return visit required due to vehicle unavailability or other issues outside our control will be chargeable at full cost.

- **Vehicle Access & Movement**

- If vehicles need to be repositioned during the works, a driver must be on-site and available throughout.
- Our team is **not licensed, insured, or permitted** to drive or move vehicles.

- **Vehicle Condition**

- All vehicles must be thoroughly washed before installation. Dirt, grease, or debris will prevent proper adhesion of the Spedian system.
- Any pre-existing issues such as paint damage, irregular surfaces, corrosion, or rust will be noted and reported to your nominated site contact prior to work commencing.

- **Work Environment**

- Each vehicle should be located undercover in a dry, sheltered space with:
 - Minimum ambient temperature of **10°C**
 - Adequate overhead and side lighting
 - Utilities (e.g., power supply if required)
 - Clear, unobstructed access around the vehicle
- The work area should be well-ventilated, clean, and reasonably free from dirt, dust, and obstacles.

- **Risk Assessment**

- Our certified installers will conduct an on-site risk assessment before starting. Any identified hazards must be addressed to ensure a safe and compliant installation process.

Subsequent Banner Changes

One of the advantages of the Spedian system is the speed and ease of changing graphics. For banner replacements, please prepare the following:

- Vehicles do not need to be undercover, unless structural repairs to the Spedian frame are required.
- Ensure safe, level ground with unrestricted access to all sides of each vehicle (Approx 1m each side).
- The work area must be free from moving traffic and other operational hazards.

Liability & Client Responsibilities

- Our operatives will not require vehicle keys or access to the vehicle interior at any time.
- Roadvert Ltd staff are not permitted or insured to drive vehicles.
- Clients are responsible for:
 - Providing secure access to vehicles for the duration of works
 - Ensuring vehicles and their contents are safeguarded

Aftercare – Maintaining Your Spedian Graphics

Proper care will extend the lifespan and visual impact of your graphics. Please observe the following cleaning guidelines:

- Use a mild liquid detergent and water mix, free from aggressive solvents.
- Avoid cleaners with high acidity or alkalinity.
- First, rinse with clean water to remove loose dirt.
- Wash gently with a soft brush, sponge, or cleaning cloth.
- Never use hard-bristled brushes or abrasive cleaning tools.
- Always finish by rinsing thoroughly with clean water.

Pressure Washing Guidelines

The Spedian system is compatible with pressure washing, provided it is handled correctly:

- Maintain a minimum distance of **1 metre** between the nozzle tip and the graphics.
- Keep the spray at a shallow angle to avoid forcing water under the graphic edges.
- Avoid prolonged exposure to a single spot.
- Water temperature range of 61C to 71C

Banner Storage – Protecting and Reusing Your Spedian Graphics

One of the key advantages of the Spedian system is that banners can be reused multiple times, providing excellent flexibility and value. To maximise their longevity and ensure they remain in optimal condition, please follow these storage guidelines:

- **Clean Before Removal**

- All banners should be thoroughly cleaned & dried prior to removal to prevent dirt, dust, or contaminants from being trapped during storage.

- **Correct Rolling Method**

- Once removed, banners will be carefully rolled into groups of three (3) and labelled.
- Rolling prevents creasing, folding, or structural stress that could compromise the integrity of the graphics and system.

- **Storage Environment**

- Store rolled banners in a clean, dry location, away from direct sunlight, moisture, and sources of heat.
- Always position banners upright to avoid flattening or distortion.
- Do not stack heavy objects on top of stored banners.

By adopting these storage practices, your Spedian banners will remain in excellent condition, ready to be refitted and reused whenever required.

By following these steps, you'll help ensure a smooth, efficient installation and long-lasting, professional-looking graphics.
